Category One Narrative

There is no formal RFP for any of the services requested in this 470, but it is important for all service providers read and respond to the attached RFP documents when preparing their bids.

We seek an additional managed internet access bundled with a transport circuit with no bias regarding circuit material. We have chosen the three drop down functions above to ensure that limitations of the EPC system do not limit service provider bidding options with symmetrical bandwidth at 100 Mbps This is the true maximum capacity we for which we expect to see pricing with guaranteed throughput to the WAN headend at Hebron Middle School, 307 S. Main Street, Hebron, IN 46341 beginning July 1, 2018. This additional 100Mbps line will be dedicated to secure student online testing in MSD of Boone Township's computer labs.

The school district will require approximately 2+/- public IPv4 addresses. Please provide individual or block pricing for additional addresses to account for potential growth during the term of the contract. You may also provide optional pricing for the technical equivalent number of IPv6 addresses. Preference will be given to a vendor who will allow the school district to keep their existing Class C IPv4 addresses.

The proposal must include any service provider owned onsite equipment necessary to hand off service to the District's head-end equipment, and you should describe your proposed hand-off as part of your response.

Please see attached RFP for details on the proposed Service Level Agreement (SLA). An SLA must be included in your bid response.

If there are any separate installations or special construction costs necessary to bring a service to our head-end, the cost proposal must clearly delineate those costs from monthly recurring costs, and the service provider must be prepared to assist with any USAC review questions concerning those costs (Examples attached as RFP document "Potential FCC/USAC review questions").
