HMS REMAINS A SCHOOL TO WATCH

Hebron Middle School has been redesignated as a School to Watch. The National Forum for Middle Grades Reform awards schools around the country this distinction for academic excellence, developmental responsiveness, social equity and strong organizational processes. HMS earned the original designation in 2012 and is only one of 16 other schools in Indiana to earn this award. Additionally, Hebron is only one of 5 schools in the state to be designated for the fourth time!
