Lions Club International is an international secular, non-political service organization founded by Melvin Jones in 1917. Lions have served the world's population through hard work and commitment to make a difference in lives of people everywhere. With 1.4 million members serving in more than 46,000 clubs in over 200 countries around the world. Lions Club International is the world's largest service club organization. Lions are recognized worldwide for their service to the blind and visually impaired, diabetes awareness, international relations, youth outreach and environmental services.

Indiana Lions collect old eyeglasses and take them to the Ladies Correctional Institution. Over a million pairs of glasses are categorized each year. Volunteers, doctors, fitters and helpers go to third world countries to help the poor visually impaired.

Hebron Lions Club was chartered in 1969. Over the years, our club has planned and participated in a variety of service projects. We have purchased eyeglasses for those who could not afford them, held fundraisers for individuals with cancer, helped the local Cub Scouts, helped the local food pantry, organized the Angel Tree project and supported many other organizations in the community.

In 1982, the John Blank Memorial Scholarship was established in honor of John Blank who passed away on July 17, 1981. John was a father, a teacher, a lion, a soldier, and a friend. The Hebron Lions Club Memorial Scholarship was established in 2000 to honor those who served the Hebron Lions. In 2014, the two scholarships merged into one and was renamed the *Hebron Lions Club John Blank Memorial Scholarship*.

3. Two letters of recommendation from faculty members (such as a teacher, club sponsor, guidance counselor, etc.)

Criteria for eligibility for Scholarship

- Completion of scholarship application, essay, and two letters of recommendation **turned in to the Guidance Office by April 20, 2022.**
- Official graduation from Hebron High School during the current school year.
- Must be in good academic standing. Please provide a copy of your High School Transcript.
- Letter of Acceptance by an accredited university, college, or vocational school. Please provide a copy of the letter.
