(Orthodontics, Inc) patient (who has/had upper and lower braces) and who is a college-bound high school senior is eligible to enter. You must complete a one-page essay entitled: **“The Importance of A Healthy Smile”** and submit the appropriately endorsed data page.

ENTRY DEADLINE: All entries must be **postmarked by Friday, April 15, 2016** and mailed in an unfolded manila envelope with sufficient postage to:

SCHOLARSHIP NOTIFICATION: Winners will be notified no later than **Friday, May 6, 2016** by telephone and it will be announced in local newspapers.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: There will be two (2) \$500.00 scholarships awarded. Two winners will be chosen. A panel of judges will select the winning essays with no knowledge of the identity of the authors except a date of birth and attending high school. Data pages are used for information such as eligibility and identification. The winners will be selected based on ability to organize, compose, and neatly type a one-page essay and complete one data page as directed. **Content and originality are more important than the quality of type.**

INSTRUCTIONS: **Following instructions are the key to success for many projects in college and beyond.**

- Our office staff may not be asked for advice concerning the essay. It would not be fair to others.
- Your essay should be typed, double-spaced, and on standard 8 ½ x 11 white typing paper. (A computer, word processor, or typewriter may be used.)
- Not following instructions will disqualify your essay.**

ESSAY PAGE:

- Type your high school name in the upper left corner and your date of birth (in MM/DD/YYYY format) in the upper right-hand corner.
- Title your essay – “The Importance Of A Healthy Smile” (please do not use your own title)
- Do not put your name on the essay page.
- Do not attach the essay page to the data page.
- Do not return the instruction sheet with your essay.

DATA PAGE:

- Complete the Hurst Orthodontics, P.C. DATA PAGE (type or print clearly). Make sure you have all names, phone numbers and signatures required.
- Submit a wallet size individual photo with your essay and data page. Write your name on the back of your photo in case it should become separated from the data page.
- DO NOT** send a high school transcript.
- DO NOT** bend, fold or attach the pages together.
- DO NOT** drop off your essay at the offices.
- MAIL** the essay and completed data page in an appropriately sized envelope **postmarked no later than Friday, April 15, 2016.**
- Materials submitted are the property of Hurst Orthodontics, P.C.
- Essays and pictures (not data pages) may be posted.
