1. A completed student application form.

3. A parent letter of recommendation.
4. A faculty member letter of recommendation (such as a teacher, club sponsor, guidance counselor, etc.).
5. Active involvement in student related activities to promote a drug free lifestyle, such as PRIDE, SADD, Natural Helpers, etc.

Each item will be considered when determining the winner. The money will be awarded upon entry into college or vocational school in the fall of 2018.
