

The Karen Jania Artistic Student Award

- Established October 26, 2019 by the Town of Hebron
- \$3,000.00 total funds available for the award
- Each year in May, during the Hebron High School Academic Awards Night, one Hebron High School senior art student will receive a \$300.00 award from the Town of Hebron in honor of Mrs. Karen Jania for her outstanding commitment and her work on the Towns Historic Past and its Brilliant Future Mural. The recipient will be based on the award committee's review of all applications, ultimately selecting the best candidate to receive the award
- The Town's \$3,000.00 Award donation will be deposited in the **Hebron Schools Education Foundation's** account and \$300.00 will be made available each year in May to present one student, chosen by the Town of Hebron, with the award
- When the \$3,000.00 award money runs out, it runs out! (Anticipated: May, 2029, \$300.00 X 10 years = \$3,000.00)
- In the event that there are no applications during any given year, the \$300.00 award money will remain in the Hebron Schools Education Foundation account and will roll over to the following year.
- Only one award will be presented each year
- Application is due to the Guidance Office by Friday, April 22, 2022.

Award Criteria:

- Students must be art students in their senior year and apply to receive the award
- Students must complete and submit an application for the award (See application below)
